WHEREAS, recent drug price increases have raised the cost of previously generic drugs significantly; and

WHEREAS, drug pricing adversely affects patient health; and

WHEREAS, non-profit organizations exist to examine the economic cost-to-benefit value of various drugs and raise awareness of drugs that have undergone dramatic price shifting; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Commission on Public Health of the Kentucky Medical Association research regional organizations that evaluate drug pricing and value to assess possible benefits for patients and physicians in Kentucky.
