Get a list of every Kentucky-based addiction treatment provider accepting clients right now.

Will you be ready?

When you or a loved one is ready to seek help for a drug addiction (also known as a substance use disorder), don't let the moment pass. At this critical time, it's important to be equipped with treatment options as quickly as possible.

Finding treatment is easier than ever.

Instead of wasting precious time searching the internet and spending hours on the phone, you can **FIND HELP NOW**. In less than a minute, you can get a list of every treatment provider accepting clients right now.

Answer five optional questions, such as:

- > Location
- > Type of treatment (residential, inpatient, medical detox, outpatient, etc.)
- > **Payment** (options range from free to private insurance)

All information that's submitted is confidential and will only be used to find the help you need.





What information about the treatment centers is available?

You'll get a detailed description of each facility, which includes (but is not limited to):

- > Admissions criteria
- > Prescription medication policy
- > Tobacco use policies
- > Educational classes offered (such as parenting, DUI, etc.)
- > Other services (mental health, case management, peer support, etc.)

You can also narrow down your search even further using over 20 advanced filter options.
