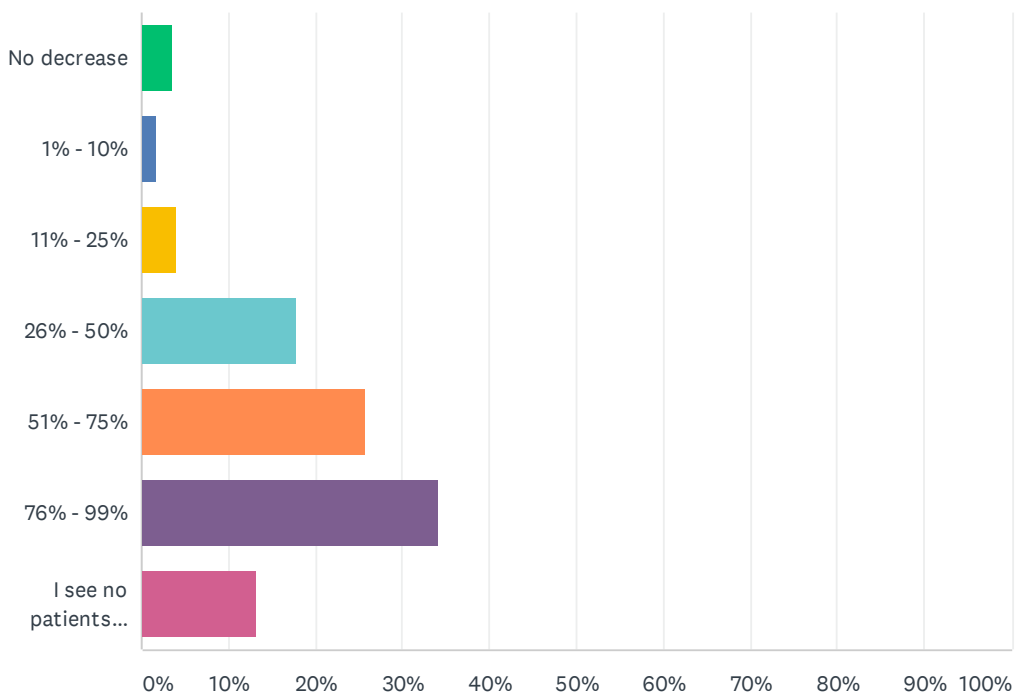


What would you estimate is the percentage decrease in the number of patients you have seen per week due to the COVID-19 pandemic?

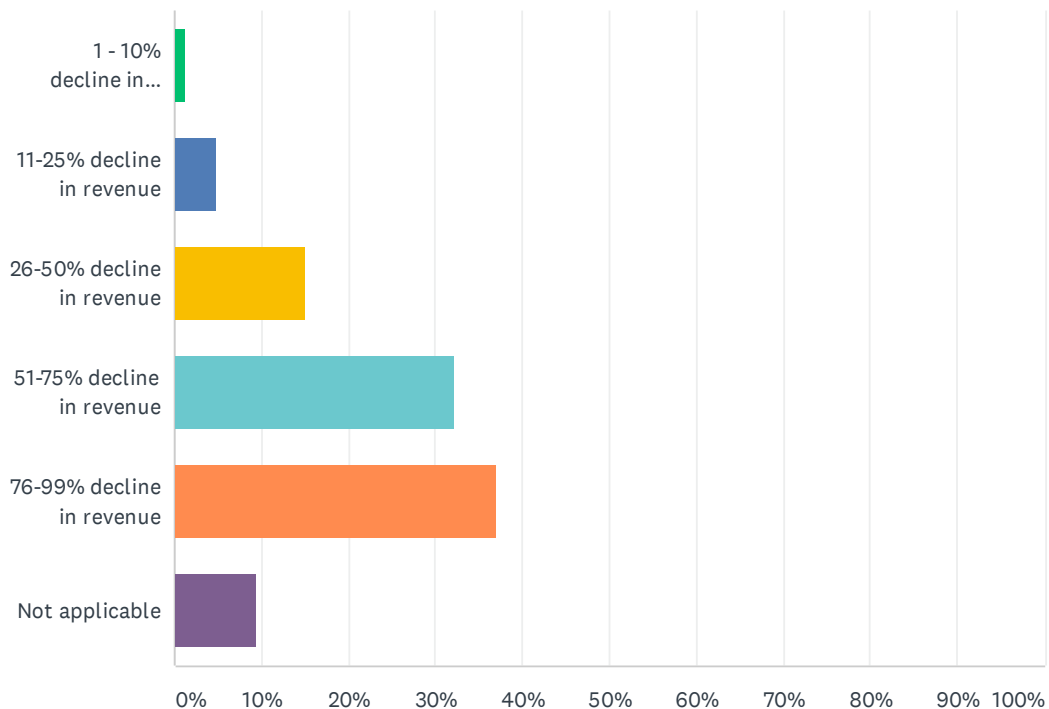

If the volume of patients seen in your practice has decreased since the COVID-19 pandemic, what has been the estimated financial impact on your practice?

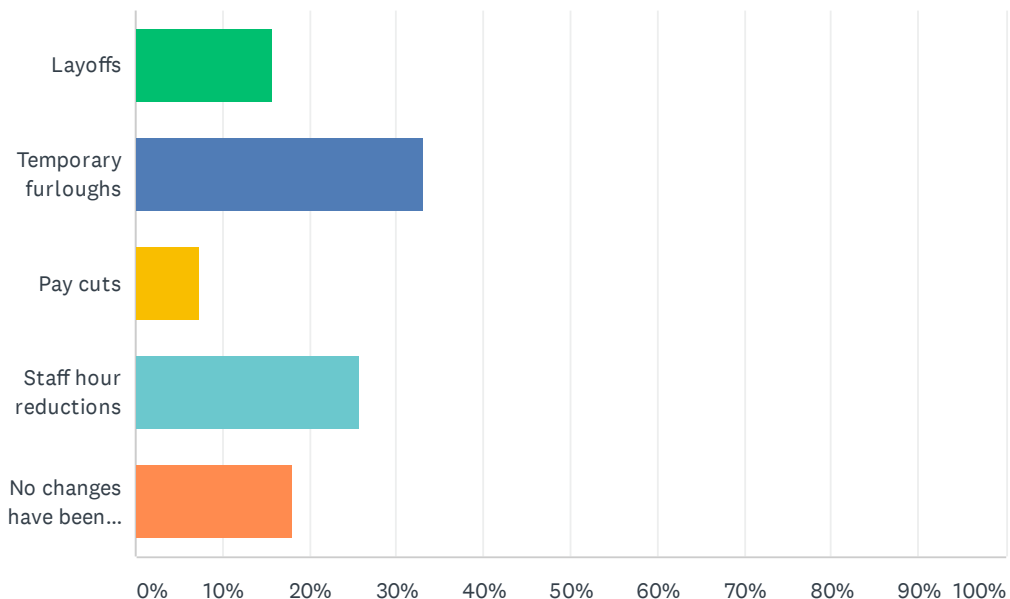

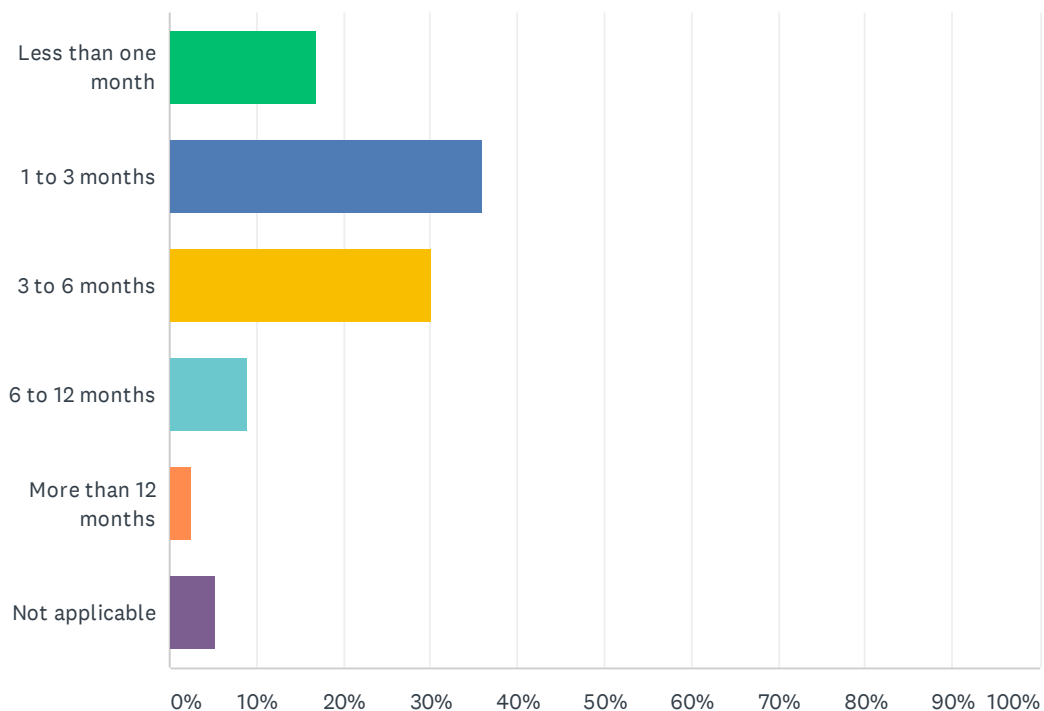

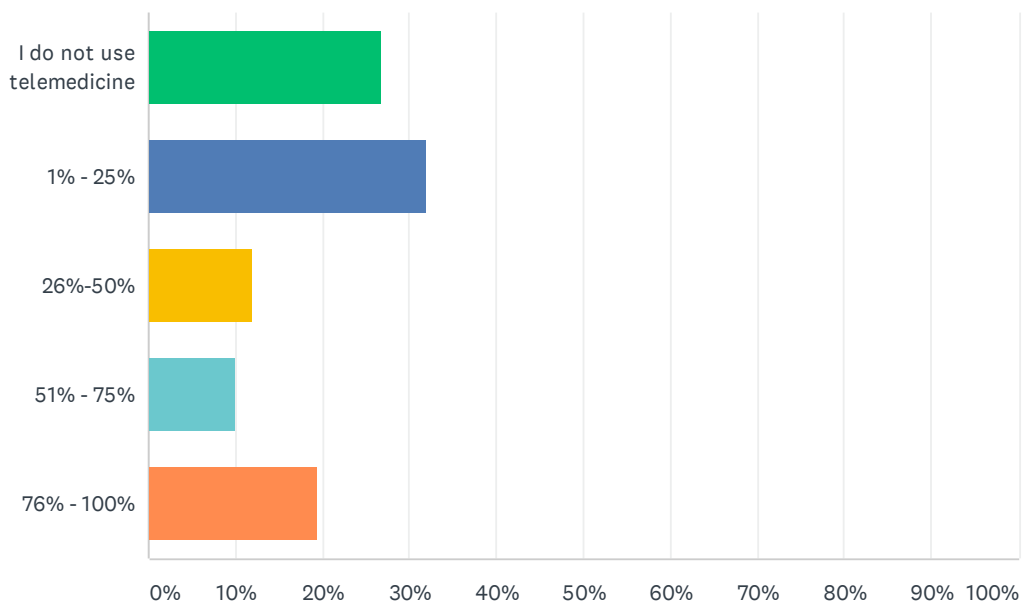

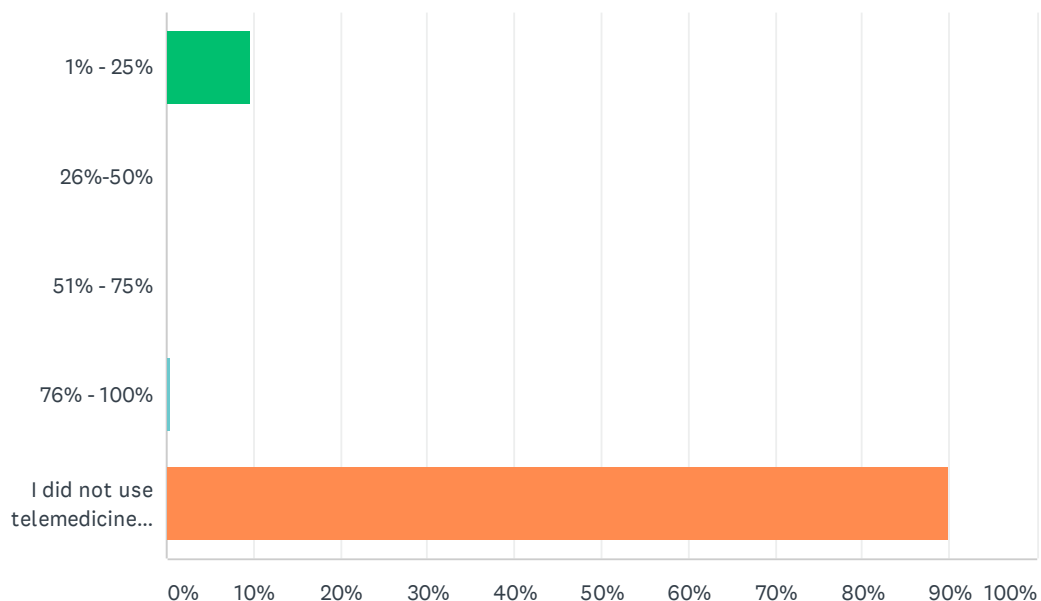

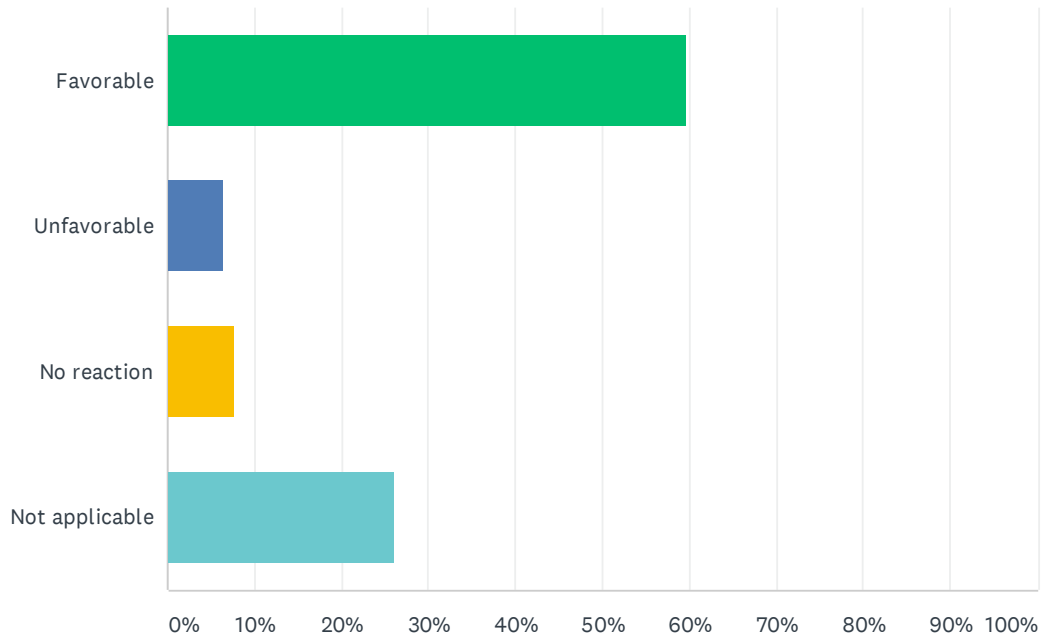

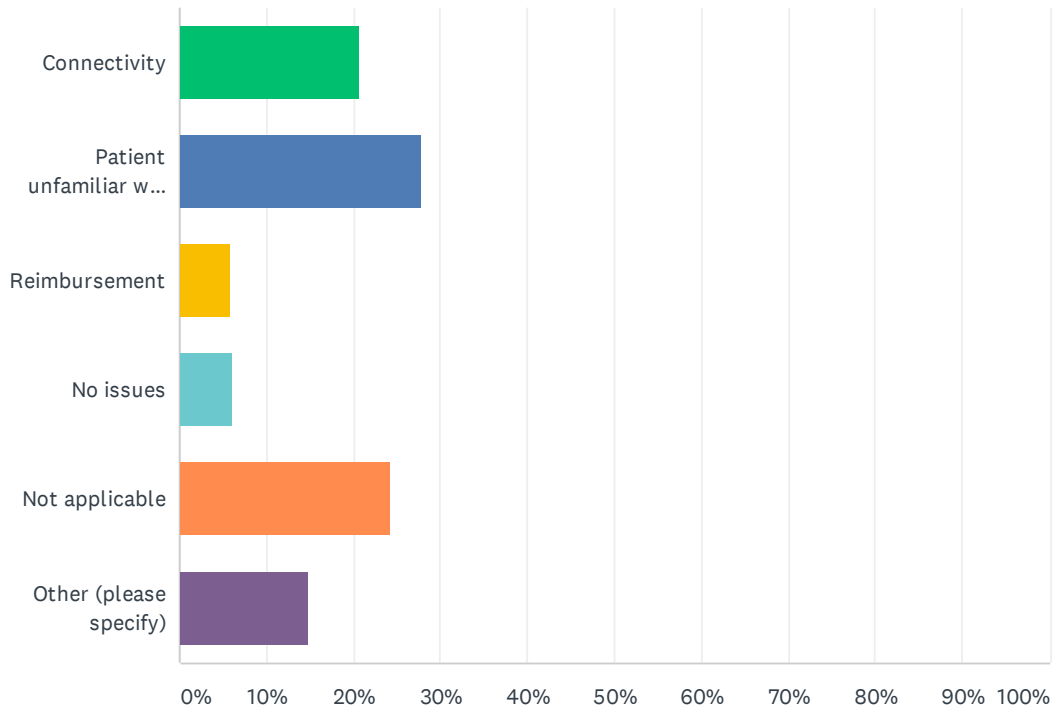

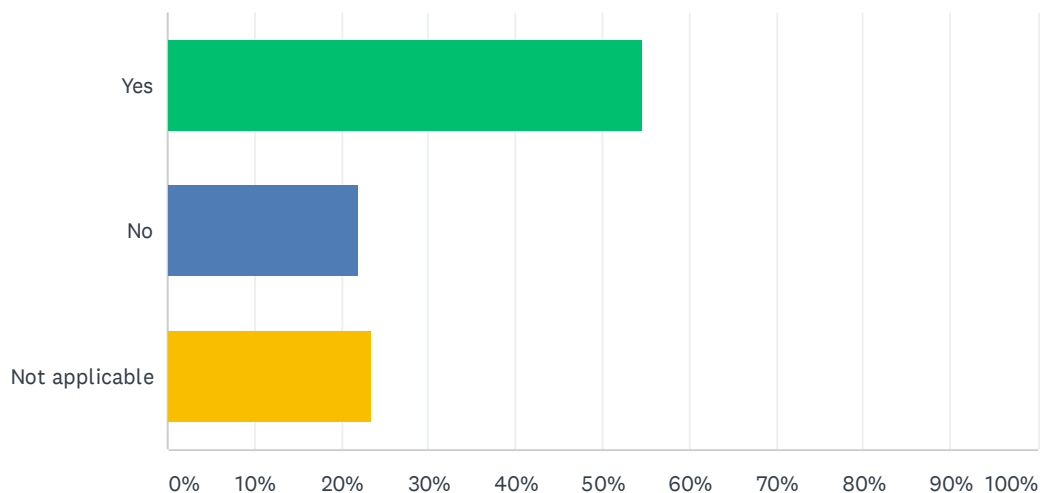

Do you plan to continue treating patients using telemedicine after the COVID-19 pandemic subsides?

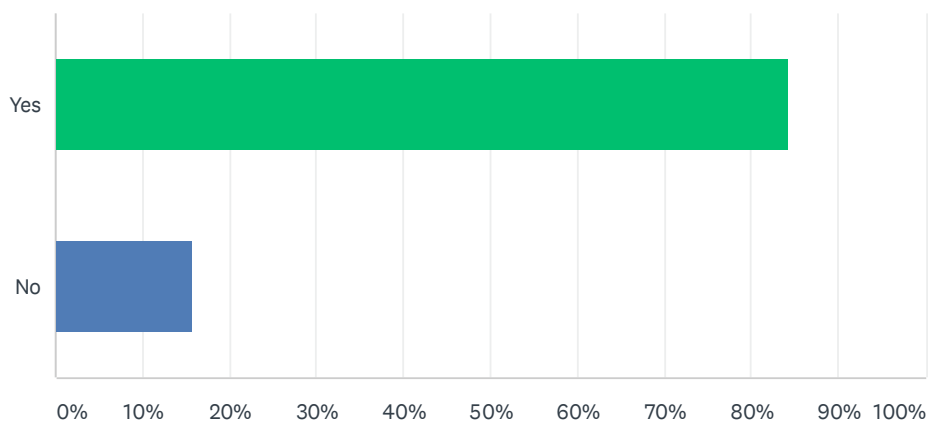

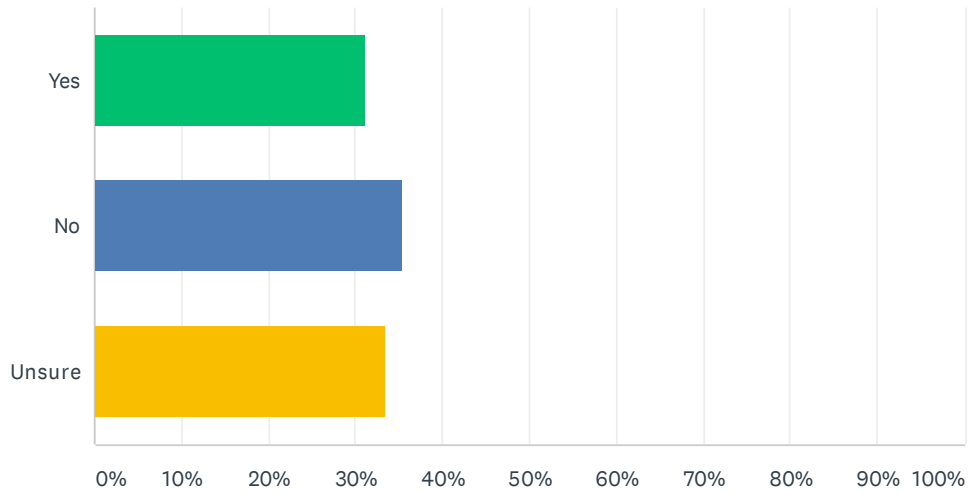

Have you or your practice received grant funds as outlined above?

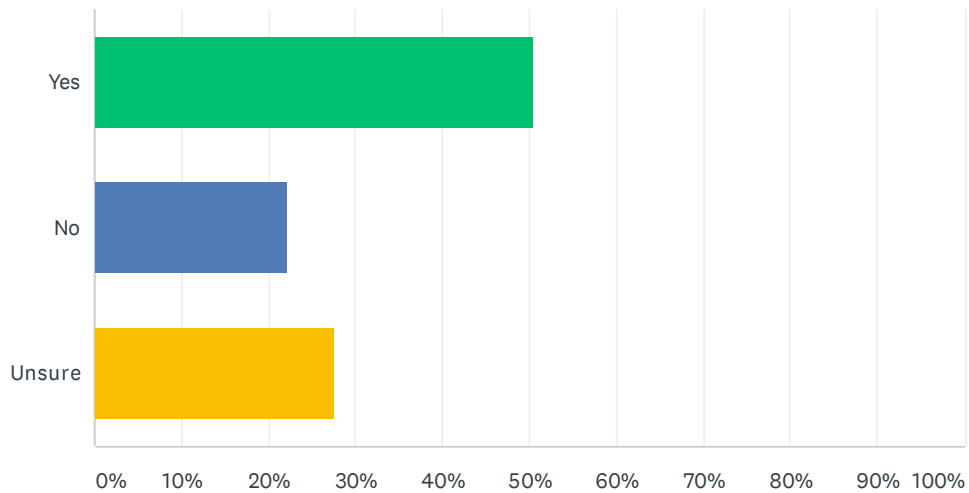
